We will try to keep these going through the winter with winter flowering plants to provide a show. We will also be decorating the club in early December for Christmas. There will be a Christmas Carol concert at Anmer on Wednesday 22nd December at 4.30 – places need to be booked in advance. Afterwards, back to the club for mulled wine, mince pies etc.
